New and returning graduate and undergraduate students should complete registration before Sunday, Jan 13th.

Academic Schedule – Classes for the Spring semester will commence on Monday, Jan 14th.

All international students and scholars moving to new on-campus or off-campus housing must update the US Address via "MySlice self-service" -> **CURR address**. You must update your address immediately in order to be in compliance with the Immigration regulations. If you do not update your address you will be jeopardizing Immigration status while you are here at Syracuse University.

Please always update your address within 10 days of your move on MySlice.
