Important Issues

Caution: Inappropriate Academic Assistance

The Office of Academic Integrity has alerted the Slutzker Center about e-mails that were sent to SU students offering questionable academic assistance for a fee. These offers claim to complete courses for you or offer other fraudulent services. Replying to such an offer could jeopardize you in many ways. Most importantly, such services violate SU's academic integrity policy and could result in expulsion from the University. An Expulsion or suspension will lead to your SEVIS record being terminated.

Your potential use of Fraudulent services also threaten the reputation of the university. If you receive such an offer please notify SU's Academic Integrity Office or Information and Technology Services, so that they can notify students of possible scams.

All full-time, matriculated international students will be automatically enrolled in the new Health Insurance Plan on August 1, 2015.
