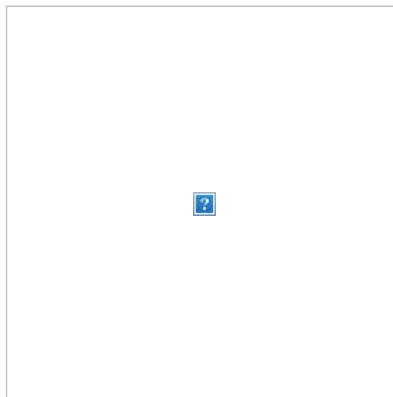

What Do People Do?

The Thanksgiving feast commemorates a harvest meal shared by the Plymouth colonists and Wampanoag Indians in 1621. Colonies and states continued to hold their own days of thanksgiving until 1863 when, in the midst of the Civil War, President Abraham Lincoln proclaimed a national Thanksgiving Day.

Thanksgiving is a federal holiday in both the US and Canada although it is celebrated on different days. President Franklin D. Roosevelt signed a joint resolution of Congress on December 26, 1941 which officially changed the US national Thanksgiving Day from the last Thursday in November to the fourth Thursday*.
